We start with Jean Kidwell with a great technique, starting with Duncan Envision Glaze, tracing on pattern, block pattern with wax resist and then carving through to wax resist. Using a liner brush we applied Black Concepts to the sgrafitto lines. This gave me lots of ideas that would be wonderful with this technique, thanks Jean. Took a quick break, then on to Pert Fullers technique sand painting on top of True Pastel Matt glaze, this time we added silica sand to Concepts to give our design a 3D look. We all left with our great projects from day 2. A group of very happy painters... Everyone was looking forward to Day 3, Turn in again tomorrow for the last chapter of the Desert Spice Coyotes Annual Retreat....
